Welcome Message


On behalf of the Organizing Committee of the 10th Nagoya International Blood and Marrow Transplantation (BMT) Symposium, I would like to welcome all participants in Nagoya. This bi-annual symposium was organized by Nagoya BMT Group and Yakult Honsha Company in order to provide an international forum for exchanging the up-to-date information and experiences.



Hematopoietic stem cell transplantation (HSCT) keeps increasing in numbers and the global activity survey conducted by Worldwide Network for Blood and Marrow Transplantation (WBMT) revealed that the projected HSCT (autologous and allogeneic) numbers through the entire world reached one million by the beginning of 2013. Nevertheless, it is also true that even in relatively developed countries, more than half of potential demands of HSCT are remained to be served by this medical technology and one of the major reasons is lack of appropriate hematopoietic stem cell sources.

This symposium is organized to reconsider the possibilities and appropriateness of various stem cell sources such as one-haplotype-mismatched family donors and cord blood stem cells. This subject is critically important at this moment not only to fulfill the remaining demands of HSCT in developed countries but also appropriately to initiate HSCT in emerging countries where the resources are limited. We hope we could get certain consensus on this subject through this symposium.

We are happy that internationally prominent investigators from North America, Europe and Asian countries as well as active domestic investigators participate in this program and we expect that all the participants could get fruitful results after the symposium. We also hope that this symposium would offer a good opportunity to exchange information regarding to other topics as well as to create real friendships among the participants.
